

Firefighters' & Rescue Squad Workers' Pension Fund Helpful Tips & Checklist

Firefighter Eligibility

To be an "eligible firefighter," you must be 18 or older and belong to a fire department that:				
	is rated by the Fire Insurance Rating Bureau and is certified by the Department of Insurance as not less than a Class "95" department, files a roster annually with the North Carolina State Firefighters' Association, which is forwarded to the Pension Fund by January 31 each year, and			
	holds training sessions at least 4 hours monthly for which members are required to attend at least 36 hours per year.			

Rescue Squad Workers Eligibility

To be an "	eligible rescue squad worker," you must be 18 or older and belong to a rescue squad that:
	is eligible for membership in the North Carolina Association of Rescue and Emergency Medical Services Inc.,
	files a roster annually with the North Carolina Association of Rescue and Emergency Medical Services Inc which is forwarded to the Pension Fund by January 31 each year, and
	attend a minimum of 36 hours of training sessions each year.


Becoming a Member

Γο become	a member of this pension fund, you must:		
	Complete an enrollment application (<u>Form 350, Enrolling in the Firefighters' and Rescue Squad Worke Pension Fund</u>) through your department or squad, and		
	Mail it with your first payment (contributions are \$10 per month) to:		
	Firefighters' and Rescue Squad Workers' Pension Fund Department of State Treasurer 3200 Atlantic Avenue Raleigh, NC 27604		
	Your enrollment date will be effective in the month in which the pension fund receives both your application and first contribution.		
	We recommend you complete Form <u>2FR (Designating Beneficiary(ies) for the Firefighters' and Rescue Squad Workers' Pension Fund)</u> as soon as possible and mail it to the address above or by email to <u>Specialty.Plans@nctreasurer.com</u> .		
_	for ORBIT or ORBIT or online portal for members.		
	Visit ORBIT and select Register. Follow the steps to create a new account.		
	Designate beneficiaries in ORBIT by clicking the Maintain Beneficiaries tab. This feature is available for active members and updates are effective immediately.		
	Log in to ORBIT to track your service and contributions.
