- Fourth issue released December 2018
- Emailed to 18,839 LGERS units, Pension Fund members and departments/squads who have emails on file
- Included information:
 - Roster service requirements and deadlines
 - Death Benefits and payments to Beneficiaries
 - Online TAD submission updates





Turnaround Documents

- Phase I of the Online TAD began March 2019
- Internal staff began processing TADs received online
- Development of Department/Squad electronic submission began late 2018
- Pilot with departments/squads will be completed prior to launch
- After launch, departments will be able to:
 - Administer access for designated staff
 - Add, delete or reset any user access and password
 - Enter contribution amounts through ORBIT for each member of your department/squad who has met service and training requirements
 - Enroll new members using Self Service functionality
 - Remove non-contributing members from the TAD
 - Mail a check for total contributing members identified on the TAD screen
