## **Proxy Voting Activity Summary**

- The Department renewed the contract with proxy advisor Glass Lewis in September 2017. The vendor continues to provide services to both the Investment Management Division and the Supplemental Retirement Plans. A flat service fee applies regardless of the number of ballots voted and the Department obtained a discount due to a multi-year commitment. The fee is prorated between IMD and SRP based on the total votes cast for each.
- The Board adopted the Glass Lewis in-house proxy voting policy in December 2017. The implementation of the policy significantly reduced the need for "case-by-case" voting by the staff.
- In the past 12 months, the plans voted a total of 6,298 proposals. In comparison, during the June 1, 2018-2019 season, 8,936 were voted.
