

Firefighters' & Rescue Squad Workers' Pension Fund Helpful Tips & Checklist

Firefighter Eligibility Rescue Squad Workers Eligibility To be an "eligible firefighter," you must be 18 or To be an "eligible rescue squad worker," you must older and belong to a fire department that: be 18 or older and belong to a rescue squad that: is eligible for membership in the North is rated by the Fire Insurance Rating Bureau and is certified by the Department Carolina Association of Rescue and of Insurance as not less than a Class "9S" Emergency Medical Services Inc., department, files a roster annually with the North files a roster annually with the North Carolina State Firefighters' Association, Carolina Association of Rescue and Emergency Medical Services Inc., which is which is forwarded to the Pension Fund by forwarded to the Pension Fund by January January 31 each year, and 31 each year, and attend a minimum of 36 hours of training holds training sessions at least 4 hours monthly for which members are required to sessions each year. attend at least 36 hours per year.

Becoming a Member

To become a member of this pension fund, you must:

П	Complete an enrollment application (Form 350, Enrolling in the Firefighters' and Rescue Squad Workers'
ш	Pension Fund) through your department or squad, and

As of Jan. 1, 2025, the monthly contribution is \$15 per month. Mail your completed application and the first payment to:

Your enrollment date will be effective in the month in which the pension fund receives both your application and first contribution.

We recommend you complete Form <u>2FR (Designating Beneficiary(ies) for the Firefighters' and Rescue Squad Workers' Pension Fund)</u> as soon as possible and mail it to the address above or by email to <u>Specialty.Plans@nctreasurer.com</u>.

Register for ORBIT



Once you are enrolled in the pension, you should register for ORBIT, the online portal for members.


Visit ORBIT and select Register. Follow the steps to create a new account.

Designate beneficiaries in ORBIT by clicking the Maintain Beneficiaries tab. This feature is available for active members and updates are effective immediately.

Log in to ORBIT to track your service and contributions.

Your member handbook is your one-stop resource for all the details and laws that impact your pension benefits.



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You may apply for monthly pension fund benefits after you:

Have 20 years of creditable service as a firefighter or rescue squad worker, and

Reach age 55.

Receiving Benefits

To begin receiving benefits, you must complete and submit to the Pension Fund:

Form 6FR, "Retiring from the Firefighters' and Rescue Squad Workers' Pension Fund"

Form 170, "Authorizing Direct Deposit"

You must apply for benefits. They are not paid automatically. Your application and direct deposit form should be returned to the Pension Fund 30 days before your scheduled retirement date.

As of Jan. 1, 2025, the pension fund benefit is \$175 per month.
